Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014

Cornwall Council Public Spaces Protection (Dogs on Beaches) Order 2023

Cornwall Council hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come in force on 14 April 2023 for a period of 3 years.
- 2. This Order applies to the land specified and during the periods specified in Schedules 1 to 3.

This Order revokes the following Order made under the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014;

The Cornwall Council Public Spaces Protection (Dogs on Beaches) Order 2020 of 13 April 2020.

Offence

- 3. A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, during the periods specified in Schedule 1 to 3, a person takes a dog onto, or permits a dog to enter or to remain on, any land to which this Order applies unless;
- a. One has a responsible excuse for doing so; or
- b. The owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land consented (generally or specifically) to this action.

A person who habitually has a dog in their possession shall be taken to be the person in charge of the dog at that time.

Exemptions

- 4. This Order does not apply to any person who:
- a. Is registered as a blind person in a register compiled under Section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948; or
- b. Is deaf, in respect of a dog trained by Hearing Dogs for Deaf People and upon which he relies for assistance; or

- c. Has a registered disability which requires being in charge of an Assistance Dog which is registered with Assistance Dogs UK and upon which they rely for assistance;
- d. Working dogs: When actually working e.g. those working on a land under the control of a farm worker when moving livestock. Working dogs includes dogs that are being used in connection with emergency Search & Rescue, Law Enforcement and the work of HM Armed Forces

Penalty

5. Failure, without a reasonable excuse, to comply with the prohibitions imposed by this Order, as set out above, would be a criminal offence.

A person guilty of such an offence, under Section 67 of the Act, would be liable on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding level 3 (currently £1,000) on the standard scale.

Cornwall Council, can at its discretion, issue a fixed penalty notice in the sum of £100 to a person believed to have committee an offence under this Order their discharging the liability for prosecution.
